

**CHAPTER 7****PASS / CUT OFF PERCENTAGE & CONDUCT OF EXAMINATION, INTERVIEW AND MEDICAL BOARD****1. SCHEME OF EXAMINATION.**

The RIMCEE-2026 consists of Stages as per details given below :

Written Examination → Viva Voce → Medical → Final Merit/ Admission

**Stage-I : Written Examination**

**NOTE :**

- The medium of Exam will be bilingual (English and Hindi) except the questions in English Language. There will be no negative marking.
- In case of any ambiguity in translation/construction of a question in the exam, its English version (except for the Language section questions) shall be treated as final and the decision of NTA shall be final in this regard.
- Candidates passing in RIMCEE-2026 would be eligible for admission, irrespective of the medium of the examination, subject to meeting other eligibility criteria.**
- The timeline for the Stage-II viva voce would be informed separately through the official website <http://www.rimc.edu.in>.
- Representations regarding discrepancies in answer sheets of the candidates will be entertained within 03 Months of declaration of Result only.

**Stage-II :Viva Voce**

- The viva-voce will be held for only those candidates who qualify the Written Exam.** The list will be sent to the respective State Governments by RIMC after approval from HQ ARTRAC. **The date for viva-voce** (designed primarily to test the **intelligence, personality, & communication skills** of candidates) **will be intimated later.**
- The intelligence and personality of the candidate will be tested in the Interview.** It is mandatory to pass the Interview as well. **50% Marks must be obtained.**

- (c) The wards of Central Government employees can take their exam and viva-voce at the place of posting of either employee or Domicile State, however, their candidature will be considered from their original Domicile State. **It is, therefore mandatory for such candidates to inform the Domicile State while submitting the application online.**
- (d) The constitution of the selection board is briefly mentioned in the Regulations Governing RIMC and shall be as follows, however, the RIMC reserves the right for any modifications at a later stage : -
- Chief Secretary to the Government or in case the State Government so desires, any other Secretary of the State Government nominated by him.
  - Two Military officers. (One of them should not be below the rank of Lt Col or equivalent from Army, Air Force or Navy). These officers will be detailed as far as possible from the nearest Military Station and all expenses of TA and DA etc will be borne by the Government of India.
  - The State Director of Public Institutions or Director of Education or some senior officer nominated by him.
  - Where practicable, a member of the State Public Service Commission.

### **Stage-III : Medical Examination**

- (a) The candidates who qualify the written examination and viva-voce and are included in the medical call-up list shall undergo a Medical Examination at selected Military Hospitals and only the candidates found medically fit will be considered for selection and admission to the RIMC subject to merit and vacancy.
- (b) Medical Examination of all qualified candidates will be conducted at nearest selected Hospital in consonance with AFMSF-2 (VER 2002).

### **Medical Rules:**

Medical Examination: The selected candidates post examination would have to undergo a medical examination, Information regarding medical examination to RIMC, Dehradun are given as under:

- (a) The medical examination of candidate for admission to RIMC, Dehradun will be carried out by a medical board at a Military/Air Force/Navy Hospital nearest to the residence of the candidate.
- (b) It is not possible to lay down precise standards for Height, Weight and Chest measurements for these candidates but the other medical standards should be at par with NDA standards. Medical authorities to endorse 'Fit for RIMC' at the time of Entrance Medical Board. Height and to an extent weight are constitutional qualities which are largely governed by heredity. Therefore, candidates whose parents are short stature and below normal weight may not eventually attain the minimum standard height and weight required for the Armed Forces. This point should, therefore, be borne in mind by the parents/guardians for such candidates before they seek admission at the RIMC for their children/wards.

(c) The minimum acceptable visual standards will be as under:-

- (i) Fundus & Media-To be healthy with no significant degenerative or other changes of myopia.
- (ii) Visual Fields-To be full in each eye.
- (iii) Binocular vision and stereopsis must be good.

**Note:** Mild trachoma, Stage III or IV, with regressive corneal pannus of not more than 1 to 2 mm may be accepted provided, in the opinion of the Specialist, exacerbation or deterioration are not likely.

(d) **It will be ensured that: -**

- (i) There is no evidence of weak constitution, imperfect development, serious malformation or obesity.
- (ii) There is no maldevelopment or impairment of function of the bones or joints.
- (iii) There is no malformation of the head, deformity from fracture or depression of the bones of the skull.
- (iv) There is no impaired hearing, discharge from or disease of either ear, unhealed preformation of the tympanic membranes or signs of acute or chronic suppurative otitis media or evidence of radical or modified radical mastoid operation.

**Note:** A soundly healed perforation without any impairment of the mobility of the drum and without impairment of hearing should not be a cause for rejection.

- (v) There is no disease of the bones or cartilages of the nose or nasal polyps or disease of the nasopharynx.
- (vi) There are no enlarged glands in the neck and other parts of the body and that the thyroid gland is normal.
- (vii) There is no disease of the throat, palate, tonsils or gums or disease or injury affecting the normal function of either and blood vessels. Note: Simple hypertrophy of the tonsils, if there is no history of attacks of tonsillitis, is not a cause of rejection.
- (viii) There is no sign of functional or organic disease of the heart and blood vessels.
- (ix) There is no evidence of pulmonary tuberculosis or previous history of this disease or any other chronic disease of the lungs.

**Note:** Scars of operations for the removal of tuberculosis glands are not a cause for rejection provided that there has been no active disease within the preceding 5 years and the chest is clinically and radiologically clear,

- (x) There is no evidence of any disease of the digestive system including any abnormality of the liver and spleen
- (xi) There is no hernia or tendency thereto. There is no hydrocele, or definite varicocele or any other disease or defect of the genital organs.

**Note:** A candidate who has been operated for hydrocele will be accepted if there are no abnormalities of the cord and testicle and there is no evidence of filariasis.

- (xii) There is no fistula and/or fissure of the anus or evidence of hemorrhoids.
- (xiii) There is no disease of the kidneys, cases showing albuminuria or glycosuria will not be accepted.
- (xiv) There is no disease of the skin unless temporary or trivial. Scars, which by their extent or position cause or are likely to cause disability or marked disfigurement are a cause for rejection.
- (xv) There is no active latent or congenital venereal disease.
- (xvi) There is no history or evidence of mental disease. Candidates suffering from epilepsy; incontinence of urine, or enuresis will not be accepted.
- (xvii) There is no squint or morbid condition of the eye of the-lids, which is liable to a risk of aggravation or recurrence.
- (xviii) There is no active trachoma or its complications.

**Note:** Remedial operations are to be performed prior to entry. No guarantee is given of ultimate acceptance and it should be clearly understood by the candidate that the decision whether an operation is desirable or necessary is one to be made by his private medical adviser. The Government will accept no liability regarding the result operation or any expense incurred.
